He has been teaching since 1989 and for the past 16 years as a full Professor at the department of *Political Science and History* of Panteios University, Athens. His research, writing and teaching activities have focused on the analysis of academic discourse and political ideology with area (and era) of reference postwar South (and South - East -) European societies (occasionally including Turkey).

His professional i.e. institutionalised *encadrement* was solely linked with research and teaching. In the late 70s and the 80s he was initially at the Research Department of the Bank of Greece and later attached to the Foundation of Mediterranean Studies. During the Academic year 1998-1999 he was Visiting Fellow at Princeton University (USA) and during 2005 visiting Professor at the École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales (Paris). From the mid-1990s up to the beginnings of 2000 he participated at the program 'Intelligence de la Méditerranée' co-ordinated by the CNRS and he was co-coordinator of the research Program «European Consciousness Formation in the Balkans».

He has participated in various Journal Committees among which the '*Cahiers d'Études de la Méditerranée orientale et du monde Turco-Iranien*' (CEMOTI), since 1977 he is co-editor of the social sciences review *Synchrone Themata* (Contemporary Issues) and from this position he participated at the European editorial Committee of *Liber* chaired by Pierre Bourdieu at the Collège de France.

He participated and / or still participates in various academic associations, *Greek Political Science Association*, co-founder of the Greek Society for the Comparative study of Education, the *European Consortium of Higher Education (CHER)*, the European Higher Educational Society (EAIR), *the Turkish Economic and Social History Foundation* and the Anglo-Hellenic Committee for the annual Major Book award on the Hellenic Civilization from Antiquity to Modernity.

He has participated in many conferences, seminars and has been lecturing, organizing or chairing in Greece and other Balkan, European and American Universities.

His teachings in the past decade included in Greek subjects such as: ‘Modernity and Antiquity’, Theories of the Nation and Nationalism, ‘Theory and Event’, ‘The Nationalist Ideology and its Transformations (19<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup> century)’, ‘Theorizing the Ottoman Past in the Balkans, and in English ERASMUS undergraduate and Graduate students ‘Antiquity and Modernity: The Politics of the Past’
